Manager's Memo

The only thing consistent in the financial services industry is change. The board of directors has approved a couple of changes that will be taking place over the next few months. The first change involves our drive-up window hours at our Moundridge office. Beginning April 1 our drive-up window will be open at 7:30 Monday thru Friday and close at 5:00. Saturdays the drive-up window will be open 8:00 to 12:00. If you have any questions about using our ATM's, please don't hesitate to contact us.

The other change coming is a fee for dormant accounts. We will be classifying accounts of less than \$100 that have not had any deposits, withdrawals, loan activity or certificate activity during the past two years as dormant. Dormant accounts will be subject to a \$5.00 fee per quarter. We will notify all members thirty days before their accounts are going to become dormant. If an account becomes dormant, there will be a \$10.00 fee to close the account. If your account is about to be classified as dormant and you do not want to pay any fees, you may close your account. We will reserve your old account number and make it available if you ever decide you would like to re-open the account. Because of the cost of maintaining small, inactive accounts, the board decided to encourage members with these small accounts to close them. Members under the age of eighteen will not be subject to the dormant account classification.

Mid-Kansas Credit Union will be sponsoring a community shred day on Saturday May 4th in Moundridge at the high school parking lot from 9:00 to 12:00. Anybody from the community is invited to bring any paper items that need to be shredded. All individuals and businesses are welcome to participate.

Dividend rates continue to be at record lows and there is little reason to think that will be changing anytime soon. Mid-Kansas Credit Union continues to have excess share deposits that have to be invested at these record low rates. Obviously this means we have plenty of money that we would really like to put out in loans. If you have any desire to borrow money, come talk with us and see if we can possibly help in that process. Loan rates are also low so it may be the right time to upgrade that auto, buy that ski boat or go on that long awaited vacation. Please give us a chance to help!

I would like to share a website I've found very helpful for ag management information and decision making, www.AgManager.info. Many of you may be familiar with this website, as it is associated with K-State's Department of Agricultural Economics.

Over the years I've found this site to be very practical for business purposes. In particular, the tools (spreadsheets) are helpful for decision-making. An example of a recent publication is the 2012 Kansas County-Level Land Values and Cash Rents for Non-Irrigated Cropland and Pasture.

I also want to put a plug in for their MAST program (Management, Analysis & Strategic Thinking). This program is built around two on-campus sessions that bookend self-paced online learning modules. The kick-off session is Nov. 19-20th, 2013, and concludes Feb. 18-19th, 2014, and there is a cost for the program.

While this course targets younger farmers and ranchers, the main topics of the course are essential for everyone. If anyone would like a copy of the course brochure, please let me know.
