Manager's Memo

For the first four months of 2018, we are right on budget with our income. As of April 30, 2018 we have net income of \$18,000 compared to a budgeted amount of \$19,000. It is important for us to generate positive income for the year and we are headed in the right direction. We continue to look for ways to cut expenses and increase income. The best way to increase our income is to increase loan volume so we have started doing indirect lending and also have done some loan specials. Indirect lending means that if you go to a participating dealership to buy a car and also want to finance it at the dealership, one of the lenders you can choose is Mid-Kansas Credit Union.

If you see a new teller in Moundridge, it is Olivia Duerksen. She is a Tabor College student and will be working part time this summer. John Vogt's last day was May 31 and we want to thank him for the time and effort that he put in as an ag loan officer for Mid-Kansas Credit Union and wish him well in his retirement.

How safe are your valuables?

Mid-Kansas Credit Union has safe deposit boxes available to rent in Buhler and Moundridge. The annual rent begins at \$10.00 per box. This is a bargain price for a year's worth of security. The most common items stored in boxes include birth certificates, marriage licenses, passports, mortgage documents, property deeds, titles, and financial documents such as stocks, bonds, and certificates of deposit. Jewelry, collectibles and family heirlooms can also be kept safe from theft, fire, flood, and tornadoes.

Safe deposit boxes are an affordable way to keep your most important documents and valuables safe for years to come!

How to Avoid Secret Shopper Scams

We all want to make some extra money on the side, but don't be fooled by secret shopper scams. Retail companies will hire individuals to go to stores and restaurants to report on their experiences. The retailers will then use the reports to better their products and/or services. While there are legitimate companies that hire for this part-time work, there are many scam businesses out there. Many who have fallen for these scams say they were contacted by phone or email or found the work online.

Here are a few tips to avoid falling for a secret shopper scam:

1. Do your research.

Research the company online to find out if they are legitimate.

2. Do not wire money or pay the company to start working for them.

Scammers will ask interested individuals to send them money to become a secret shopper. Don't! Once you send it, it's gone and you'll never hear from the company again.

3. Never deposit a check into your bank account from an unknown sender.

Scammers will send you a check and tell you to deposit it into your account. You are told to keep a small portion of the money as payment. The rest of it is to be used to make a purchase or make a money order to send back to the company. Here comes the bad part: The check is likely to bounce and you are responsible for paying the bank back.

4. Do not give any personal or financial information out.

Never give your Social Security Number, bank account or credit card numbers. Scammers will use this information to steal your identity and your money.

A good rule of thumb is - if it sounds too good to be true it probably is.


